- When the township permit is obtained, you MUST bring it into the office to be copied into your property file, and to receive your LHSA Permit to display in your window.
- ➤ When the tree(s) is/are **REMOVED**, you **MUST** notify the office.
- When the tree(s) is/are **PLANTED**, the **LHSA** permit is to be returned to the office to record in your property file that the replacement requirements have been completed.
